As per provisions, contained in clause under Bullet Point No 3 of Para K: Instruction to the candidate, of each of the Advertisements, mentioned in Sr. No 1 to 6 of the reference above, it is hereby notified that the Board has decided to conduct Computer Based Test (CBT), for short listing of candidates, to be called for interview, and for preparation of Overall Performance List. Accordingly, the marks distribution pattern, mentioned in clause 'H' of each of the Advertisements, mentioned in Sr. No 1 to 6 of the reference above, will be changed in the following manner.

It may be noted that, no marks will further be allotted for 'Qualification' and 'Experience', as mentioned in the original Advertisement.

**Pattern & scheme of examination:**

1. The total Marks of CBT will be 100. There will be 50 questions of 2 marks each. For each wrong answer, 0.5 marks will be deducted. The marks obtained by a candidate out of 100, will be normalized if CBT is held in more than one shifts. The marks obtained by a candidate within 100, will be scaled down by multiplying the actual marks by 0.85, to determine the marks out of 85.
2. The time duration of the CBT will be of 60 Minutes.
