No. 7/3/2026-MPSC(DR): Applications are invited for direct recruitment to **1 (one) Under Secretary (Law)** (Manipur Legal Services Junior Grade-I) and **4 (four) Law Officers** (Manipur Legal Services Junior Grade-II) in the Law & Legislative Affairs Department, Government of Manipur.

2. **Period of probation:** 2(two) years

3. **Eligibility Conditions:** -

- The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- The candidate must be able to speak Manipuri or any of the Tribal dialect of Manipur.
- The candidate must be a permanent resident of Manipur provided that a candidate whose parent or any of his/her ancestors in his/her direct lineage are permanent resident of the State, with proper documentary proof.
- Age Limit:** A candidate shall not be less than **21 years** and not more than **38 years** as on **1st January, 2026**. (Upper age limit shall be subject to any relaxation notified by the Government from time to time).

Note: *There will be NO age relaxation for the categories of candidates in cases where no posts are reserved for these categories.*

(v) **Qualifications for:**

- Under Secretary (Law)** (Manipur Legal Services Junior Grade-I) and
- Legal Officer** (Manipur Legal Services Junior Grade-II)

Essential qualifications (for A & B):

- Bachelor's degree in law from a recognised University.
- knowledge of local language of at least Middle standard.

Desirable:

- Administrative experience in Legal Work.
- Practice as an advocate for 5 years.
- Knowledge of computer application.
- Knowledge of Manipuri and Hindi.

Note 1. Candidate should possess all the requisite essential qualification on the last date of submission of application i.e. **5th May, 2026**.

Note 2. **Documents required to be uploaded by the candidate at the time of online application submission:**

- Class X marksheet and Certificate
- Class XII marksheet and Certificate
- Bachelor's Degree marksheet and Certificate in law etc.
- Experience/Desirable qualification (if any)
- Category Certificate (like ST/SC/OBCs etc. certificates).
- PRC (Permanent Resident Certificate) etc. (Domicile certificates, including any other types of residential certificates, shall not be accepted).**

CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO VERIFY AND ENSURE THAT ALL THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY UPLOADED BEFORE FINAL SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION.

4. STARTING AND CLOSING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION:

The online application should be applied at www.empsconline.gov.in w.e.f. 18th April, 2026, to 05:30 PM of 5th May, 2026 after which the link will be disabled. Submission of application in any other mode will not be entertained. All applicants should be in possession of the requisite certificates/documents as on the closing date for submission of the online application, i.e. 5th May, 2026.

Note: ‘No’ queries, representations etc. shall be entertained by the Commission in respect of correcting details that are required to be filled up by the candidates by exercising due diligence and caution as the timely completion of examination process is of paramount importance.

5. MODE OF SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

Fee: Candidates are required to pay a fee of Rs. 600/- for General & OBC and for Rs. 400/- for SC & ST by using net banking, VISA/MASTER CARD/Debit Card through www.empsconline.gov.in portal. **No fee is payable for DAPs (Differently Abled Persons).**

Note 1: Candidates should note that payment of examination fee can be made only through online mode as mentioned above. Payment of fee through any other mode is neither valid nor acceptable. Application submitted without prescribed fee/mode shall be summarily rejected.

Note 2: Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor can the fee be held in reserve for any other examination or selection.

6. All candidates in service shall submit/upload the “**NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE**” duly issued by the concerned **Department/Authority**.

7. The decision of the Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate shall be final. If on verification at any stage of the recruitment or after the recruitment, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil any of the eligibility condition, his/her candidature for the Examination will be cancelled by the Commission.

B. Interview/ Viva Voce - 30 marks

Note:

- i). Each correct answer in MCQs will earn 1 mark and there will be no negative marking for wrong answer.
 - ii). The number of candidates to be called for interview will be 5 (five) times the number of vacancies advertised among the candidates who secure 40% marks in the written examination (i.e. 120 marks in written examination). Candidates securing equal marks with the last candidate in written examination will also be called for interview.
 - iii). The final merit list of the candidates would be based on the total of the written and Interview marks. In case more than one candidate have the same total marks then, the candidate securing higher marks in the written examination will be ranked higher. In case, both the written and Interview marks are same then, the candidate securing higher marks in combined marks of Law Paper I & II will be ranked higher. In case, the total marks, written marks and Law Papers marks of written exam are all same then, the older (in age) candidate will be ranked higher.
 - iv). A candidate found to be furnishing incorrect information to the Commission, suppressing information, violating instructions, adopting various unfair means in the Examination like impersonation, cheating, etc is liable to be disqualified and/or debarred from appearing future MPSC Examinations as decided by the Commission.
 - v). **The candidature of the candidate is purely provisional subject to being found eligible in all respects.**
9. Written Examination will be held on **16th & 17th May, 2026**. The venue and detailed schedule will be notified in due course.
