City Selection Window

IMU-CET 2026

1. This is to inform all IMU-CET applicants who have successfully registered that the Examination City Selection Portal will be opened shortly for a limited duration. The portal will remain active for a 24-hour window, during which candidates will be able to view and select examination cities available under their respective first-choice state preference.
2. Candidates are required to log in to the portal within the stipulated time period and select their preferred examination city. Candidates are advised to complete the process well before the deadline. Examination city selection will be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis as per the following levels:
 - Level 1: Cities under the 1st state preference (24-hour window)
 - Level 2: Cities under the 2nd & 3rd state preferences (subsequent 24-hour window)
 - Level 3: Cities under the 4th & 5th state preferences (subsequent 24-hour window)
 - Level 4: Cities under the 6th, 7th & 8th state preferences (subsequent 24-hour window)
3. In case the vacancies under Level 1 are exhausted, candidates will be allowed to select cities under Level 2 during the next subsequent 24-hour window, and the same process will continue for the remaining levels accordingly.

4. If all examination cities under the 8 state preferences are filled, the system will display all other available examination cities across India for selection.
5. In case a registered candidate does not participate in the city selection process within the stipulated timeline, an examination city will be allotted automatically based on the availability of centres across India.
6. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the Indian Maritime University website for further updates.
